JAMES > singersongwriter/ producer

Brett James is an American country music singer, songwriter, and record producer based in Nashville. James' compositions have been credited on 494 recordings by a wide variety of artists. Among his compositions is Carrie Underwood's 2006 number-one hit "Jesus, Take the Wheel", which received Grammy Awards for Best Country Song and Best Female Country Vocal Performance. He's written 26 number-one hits for artists including Jessica Andrews, Martina McBride, Kenny Chesney, Rodney Atkins, and Jason Aldean.



Jon Randall is an American producer, songwriter, and musician. As a songwriter, Randall has had many notable cuts including "Whiskey Lullaby" recorded by Brad Paisley and Alison Krauss which won the 2005 CMA Song of the Year Award, and "Tin Man" by Miranda Lambert which won the 2018 ACM Song of the Year Award. He has also had cuts with Reba McEntire, Emmylou Harris, Maren Morris, Dierks Bentley, Kenny Chesney, Kip Moore, Brad Paisley, Scotty McCreery, Guy Clark, Little Big Town, Gary Allen and Travis Denning. Randall has been nominated for 4 Grammy Award, 5 Academy of Country Music Awards and 6 Country Music Association Awards.



LEE MILLER > sinaersonawriter/ producer

Lee Miller is an American country music songwriter and record producer. His credits include 7 number-one hits: "The Impossible" (Joe Nichols); "The World", "I'm Still a Guy" and "Perfect Storm" (Brad Paisley); "You're Gonna Miss This" (Trace Adkins); "I Just Wanna Be Mad" (Terri Clark); and "Southern Girl" (Tim McGraw). Three of his songs - "You're Gonna Miss This", "The Impossible" and "In Color" (Jamey Johnson) - were nominated for Best Country Song at the Grammy Awards. Miller also cowrote "Whiskey and You", with Chris Stapleton.



PARKER **McCOLLUM** > singersongwriter/ artist

Parker McCollum is an American Americana and country singersongwriter. His songwriting, which has been hailed by The Austin Chronicle for "carrying on the traditions of Texas music without pretension or referring to pickup trucks," earned him a publishing deal with Warner/Chappell Nashville in May 2018 and a recording deal with Universal Music Group Nashville in June 2019. Parker's latest album, Gold Chain Cowboy includes his Platinum-selling No. 1 hit "Pretty Heart" and his latest song on country radio "To Be Loved By You." In March of 2022, he won New Male Artist of the Year at the American Country Music Awards.



ROSE songwriter Liz Rose is an American country music songwriter, best known for her work with Taylor Swift. She has co-written 17 of Swift's officially released songs, including "You Belong with Me", which was nominated for the Grammy Award for Sona of the Year. "Teardrops on My Guitar", "White Horse", which won both Swift and her a Grammy Award for Best Country Song in 2010 and "All Too Well (Taylor's Version)", which reached number one on the Billboard Hot 100 in 2021. She has co-written many hits including: "Crazy Girl" (Eli Young Band), Girl Crush (Little Big Town); and many others for artist including: Blake Shelton, Tim McGraw, Martina McBride, and Carrie Underwood.



RANDY ΜΟΝΤΑΝΑ > sinaersongwriter

Nashville native, Randy Montana is an American country singersongwriter. His first album, Randy Montana, was released in 2011. When it comes to songwriting, Randy has secured more than his fair share of album cuts from big names in country music - George Strait, Jon Pardi, Luke Combs, Justin Moore, and others. Some of his hit songs include: "Beer Never Broke My Heart", "Cold As You", "Better Together" (Luke Combs); "We Didn't Have Much" (Justin Moore); and "Hope You're Happy Now" (Carly Pearce & Lee Brice).

LORI MCKENNA > singersongwriter/ artist

In addition to her career as a Grammy-nominated solo artist, McKenna is one of the music industry's most in-demand songwriters. She is the first female to ever win Songwriter of the Year at the ACMs, the first female to ever win CMA's Song of the Year two years in a row, and she also won back-to-back Grammys for Best Country Song for "Girl Crush" (Little Big Town) and "Humble and Kind" (Tim McGraw). In addition to writing songs for a multitude of award-winning artists including Miranda Lambert, Carrie Underwood, Sara Bareilles, Little Big Town, Tim McGraw, Faith Hill, Hunter Hayes and Reba McEntire, McKenna also co-wrote "Always Remember Us This Way," which was featured in the Academy Award-winning 2018 film, A Star Is Born, and received a Grammy nomination for Song of the Year.



LANE > songwriter

Tony Lane is a highly respected songwriter. He has written songs for Lee Ann Womack, George Strait, Tim McGraw, Faith Hill, Sara Evans and Randy Travis, among others. Some of his hit songs include: "Run" (George Strait), "Little Past Little Rock" (Lee Ann Womack), "On My Way To You" (Cody Johnson), "Roll with It" (Easton Corbin), "This Ain't No Love Song" (Trace Adkins), "Hello World" (Lady Antebellum) and the Grammynominated "I Need You" (Tim McGraw and Faith Hill).
